Question#1: Is the wall between the lab and offices non-load bearing?

Answer#1: Yes, it is believed that this wall is non-load bearing

Question#2: A single cost estimate associated with the final design is required or will that need updated at multiple stages of design?

Answer#2: Only a single cost estimate for the final design will be required

Question#3: Per conversation during the walk through, this will be hard bid so full specifications are required to get comparative bids correct? For mechanical or electrical scopes that are minimal, will sheet specifications be acceptable?

Answer#3: Sheet specifications will be acceptable for all scopes of work, but the sheet specifications are to be thorough enough to be referenced during bidding

Question#4: Use of alternates for lighting and ACT was discussed. Can these be additive or is there any funding that will require this to be designed so they can all be deductive alternates? We believe you want all areas designed regardless and broken into strategic areas that could easily be performed after this project is complete and could be used as a cost control measure correct?

Answer#4: All alternates are to be additive. There is no funding source that requires them to be deductive.
